Before that, he was the President and Chief Operating Officer of Computer Management Sciences, Inc. (formerly NASDAQ: CMSX), a software and services company. Throughout his seven-year tenure at Intergraph (formerly NASDAQ: INGR), Wise implemented several key business transformation and value creation strategies that resulted in meaningful growth for the company, eventually leading to its sale to Hexagon AB in 2010.

Wise currently serves on the Board of Directors of WellSky, Aspen Technology, Inc. (NASDAQ: AZPN), and Cerner Corporation (NASDAQ: CERN). Previously, he served on the Board of Directors of Cotiviti Holdings, Inc. (formerly NYSE: COTV) and Acxiom Corporation (formerly NASDAQ: ACXM), in addition to Intergraph Corporation (formerly NASDAQ: INGR) and MedAssets, Inc. (formerly NASDAQ: MDAS). Wise holds an MBA in finance and marketing from the J.L. Kellogg Graduate School of Management and a bachelor's degree in history from the University of Virginia. He is the Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of Lime Barrel Advisors, a private investment firm Wise founded in 2010.
